Bleed - Any element that prints to the edge of the printed piece must extend to this line.

Trim Line - final trim size ordered

Make sure all of your photos are 300 dpi, CMYK or grayscale. If you have any RGB files we will convert them here. FYI,.. there may be a color shift when this is applied.

When exporting, please make sure your file exports as 11.25×17.25 . Your document set up should be 11x17, and add .125" bleed all the way around. Keep all type at least .125 away from trim to ensure nothing gets cut off.

If you export the pdf with crop marks make sure the offset is .125. Do not include color bars.

It's important to extend any photos or backgrounds into your bleed. The bleed area is highlighted in pink, and this will be cut off. The purpose for bleed is to make sure there isn't a white edge when the piece is trimmed to size. If nothing is touching the edges, you can export your PDF at 11x17 no bleeds.
